Personal **Investment**

Students must be prepared to contribute money and time toward their education. Monthly family support and/or sponsors (such as grandparents, aunts/uncles or friends) can also help to assist a student. Our school schedules are designed to allow our students to help themselves with part-time or full-time employment while attending school.

Outside **Help**

This type of assistance usually comes in the form of grants and loans. Government (state, federal and local) agencies are usually involved and students and/or parents must first apply and be eligible for this type of assistance.

There are four common types of outside help - **Federal Grants, Student Loans, Private Loans and Scholarships.**

Federal Grants

Pell Grants are need-based grants that are intended to provide students access to post-secondary education. This type of federal funding does not have to be repaid. It is considered gift aid. It is available to all who are eligible and qualify. Students who wish to apply for grant funding must first submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Student Loans

Student loans are issued and managed by the U.S. Department of Education and they are the only government-backed loan program in the United States. Like federal grants, students who wish to apply for loan funding must do so through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). When applying for a student loan, you are requesting to borrow funds to assist in your educational goals. This is NOT gift aid and will need to be repaid. A financial planner will be able to assist you in determining your eligibility and how to apply.

Private Loans

Private Education Loans, also known as Alternative Education Loans, help bridge the gap between the actual cost of your education and the limited amount the government allows you to borrow in its programs. Private loans are offered by private lenders and there are no federal forms to complete. Eligibility for private student loans often depends on your credit score. This is typically done at a banking institution of your choice.

Scholarships

Scholarships are provided by some companies, professional associations, and religious groups to individuals or their family members seeking an education. We have some great resources available on our website (ogleschool.edu). Also searching the internet is a great way to see what might be available to you. Some local libraries even offer free internet usage.
